Addendum to Finding of Emergency

The Department hereby incorporates this addendum as part of the emergency readopt package. On August 23, 2024, the Department of Cannabis Control (Department) submitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) an action to readopt its emergency regulations that implement cultivation license changes pursuant to Business and Professions Code (BPC) section 26061.5.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 1, section 52(b)(1), the Department continues to make substantial progress and proceed with diligence to comply with Government Code section 11346.1(e) by working towards completion of documentation necessary to commence the regular rulemaking process. Specifically, the regulations have been through multiple rounds of stakeholder review. Moreover, the Department has completed drafting the regulation package with the Certificate of Compliance and it is undergoing the Department's internal review and approval process. The Department has prepared the present readoption package to ensure that cultivation licensees may continue to make certain changes to their licenses, including: change the type of size of a cultivation license; place a cultivation license in inactive status; or make a one-time change to a cultivation license's date of renewal. The Department anticipates filing its notice of intent to permanently adopt the emergency regulations through a Certificate of Compliance well within the readoption period.

Notwithstanding minor, technical edits, the regulation text is identical to the emergency regulation text approved in March 2024 and proposed for readoption.
